Professional Art (K & up) - Students will explore classical and traditional techniques while using different mediums. This course is taught by artist Susan Stone who has over 20 years working experience as an artist earning several awards and solo shows. Susan believes in teaching children traditional and classical methods while instilling a love for art. **COST \$50 covers instructor & supplies**

School House Rock American History (K-1, 2nd-3rd) - This fun and musical course will introduce your children to the forming moments our great country through musical jingles and DVD video clips. Beware! These songs may stay in their heads for a lifetime. **COST \$5**

Government & Elections (4th-5th, 6th, 7th-12th) - In November 2008 the United States is having a Presidential Election and the TLC Co-op is following it. The students will learn how the US government works and take an in-depth look at the electoral process. Start watching the presidential news coverage!! **COST \$5**

Botany (K-1st, 2nd-3rd, 4th-5th, 6th) - This science course will reveal to your child the amazing world of plants, specially designed by God! Discover the Creator's handiwork as you study the beauty and intricacy of seeds, leaves and flowers. This textbook, The World of Plants from God's Design for Life, will guide the children as you explore trees, fungi, algae and more. **COST \$5**

Microsoft Word (7th-12th) - This course will explain the basic usage of Microsoft Word (popular word processing software) as well as some not so obvious tricks of the trade. The material in this course will coincide with the lesson plans presented in the research writing class. Weekly access to a computer with Microsoft Word with printer are recommended. **COST \$4**

Research Writing (6th, 7th-12th) - Students will write a research paper over the eight weeks of the class. They will progress through choosing a topic, doing research, note-taking, outlining, writing a rough draft, self-editing, peer/teacher editing, and writing a final draft. Some out of class work will be required, and students will need access to the library and/or the Internet for out-of-class research. **COST \$5 for 6th GRADERS COST \$15 for 7th-12th GRADERS includes a student text**

Story Telling 101 (4th-5th) - This class will explore the reasons for and benefits of this ancient art that entertained many way before radio, tv and the internet! We will be looking at three different avenues of storytelling: collecting family stories, re-telling of an old story, and creating one of our own. We will be trying out each one of these for ourselves throughout the classes and at the end celebration be sharing our own creation with the rest of the group. **COST \$3**

Critical Thinking Games (K-1st, 2nd-3rd) - Come on and lets play games! Each week your child will learn critical thinking skills through fun worksheets and hands on games. Please be prepared to share your games from home so we can all play during class. **COST \$3**

Sports Skills Class (K-6th) - This instructional gym class will consist of motor and development games, fun recreational games as well as sports instruction on various seasonal sports. **COST \$FREE**

Prek B, 3-5 years - (THE FOREST COMES TO ME) - Your preschooler will explore the trees, animals, sounds, and artists of the forest. They will also investigate camping, conservation and Smoky the Bear. **COST \$3** *(Please send a snack including a labeled drink for each child)*

Prek B, 3-5 years - (MUSIC FUN) - This course will take our prek children on a wonderful adventure through music, movement and rhythm. A music CD of the class will be provided for each family. **COST \$2**

Prek A, 18 months-2 years - (PREK CONCEPTS) - This course will take our prek children on a wonderful review of colors, numbers, letters, and shapes all while learning through hands on activities. **COST \$3** *(Please send a snack including a labeled drink for each child)*

Prek A, 18 months-2 years - (NURSERY RHYMES & MUSIC) - This exciting dramatic class will explore well known nursery rhymes accompanied by some great musical experiences. **COST \$3**
