

# TLC Homeschoolers host the History Share during even numbered years and the Geography Share during odd numbered years

## Homeschool History Share

Your child(ren) are asked to choose a person in history in which they have an interest in or have studied. Each child is asked to put together a report and display on the life and/or events in this person's life. You could place pictures on a display board, show timelines of important events, or display famous discoveries. Use items on your display board that will add to the dynamics of your child's oral presentation. Displays and exhibits will be placed in a chronological timeline fashion--so please have your children include the dates of this person's life. Feel free to do as much or as little as you like for your display. Your child is also encouraged to present a short oral presentation on their historical person, but is not required. Your child may choose to dress as that historical person which will add to the dynamics of their oral presentation. For shy children, parents are welcomed to ask their child questions to help with the oral presentation.

## Homeschool Geography Share

Your child(ren) are to choose an area in the world in which they have an interest in or have studied. It could be as large as a continent or as small as a remote island. Discuss whatever aspects of the area you wish such as location, terrain, size, exports, people, religions, animals, famous people or discoveries. Feel free to do as much or as little as you like for your display. Your child is encouraged to present a short oral presentation on the area, but is not required. We ask that a display is created for each area discussed. You could place pictures on a display board, cook food from the area, dress as the natives of that region, or display items native to that area. Use items that will add to the dynamics of your child's oral presentation. For shy children, parents are welcomed to ask their child questions to help with the oral presentation.
